Country Harmonica Tuning. From "Harmonica World" Dec 2011. The standard Richter 10 hole harmonica tuning was devised in the early 19th century and is still used by most. Intended for "first position" chord/melody playing, it has been widely adapted to "second position" blues. That is, a harmonica in C for songs in G.

Most blues songs follow a form called the 12-bar blues. In addition to being 12 bars in length, the 12-bar blues has its own internal logic. After you grasp that logic and use it to shape your phrases, playing the blues on your harmonica will seem as natural as talking. A verse of 12-bar blues has three parts, and each part is 4 bars long.

One of the most important things about playing Country Music on Harmonica is the Country Scale: (B=Blow and D=Draw) (3D" note bent one whole step down.) 1D 2B 2D 3D" 3D 4D 5B 6B 6B 5B 4D 3D 3D" 2D 2B 1D. Use your Key of C harmonica and practice this scale. You'll be playing your C harp in 2nd position otherwise known as crosssharp.
