The Zenith Royal 500 was one of the longest running transistor radio series. It's life spanned from it's introduction in November of 1955 to it's exit in 1965. During those 10 years, it went through 7 styling changes and several performance improvements.

The Zenith Royal 500 Family - Gary's Radios

Zenith quickly became known as an innovator. It released the first portable radio in 1924, followed two years later by the first radio that operated entirely on household electricity. In 1927, Zenith introduced the first radio with push-button tuning, and in 1940 it broadcast the first FM radio station in the Midwest.

The transistor was invented in 1947 at Bell Labs in New Jersey. In 1954, Texas Instruments of Dallas teamed up with Regency Electronics (its original name was Industrial Development Engineering Associates, or I.D.E.A.) of Indianapolis to manufacture the first pocket-size transistor radio.
