When you are done with your coffee the filter, containing grounds, can be dumped into the trash leaving the pot much easier to clean.

Add a paper filter to the coffee grounds basket or use a gold-tone reusable filter. Measure and place the ground coffee directly into the basket if you have ground coffee, or place the whole beans into the hopper if you are using a grind & brew coffeemaker. The general rule is one level tablespoon per cup you are brewing, but more on that below.
