Written Schemes of Examination (WSE) Written Schemes of Examination (WSE) is a legal document required under the UK regulations. The Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 require all owners and users of pressure systems, operating above 0.5 bar (7 psi), containing pressurised hot water above 110°C or containing steam, to put in place a risk assessment and a WSE.

In Regulation 8 - Written Scheme of Examination - paragraph 100 (page 31) states that “The written scheme of examination can be written and certified as suitable either by an independent competent person or by the in-house competent person”

Who is competent?

In this case we have an engineering department who are working with pressure equipment (pumps up 20,000 psi) and they are suitably qualified to carry out the written scheme of examination. In my experience, employers with their own engineering department, NDT facilities etc usually have the insurance company do this inspection.
